## Athletic Information

The spring is just about over. Here is a rundown of how the teams finished and an update for any team still in action.

**Boys Tennis:** Finished the season with a very strong 12-3 record. Some great performances in both the BL and State tournaments. Highlights were multiple state tournament wins by Harry Honig and the doubles team of Dimitry and Sebastian Mucha.

**Girls Tennis:** A solid 7-9 record to finish the spring which was just short of qualifying for the tournament. A lot of great individual highlights throughout the season. Doubles team of Natalie Carrasquillo & Meghan Grzegorzek will compete in the states this Saturday.

**Boys Volleyball:** Finished the spring with a 3-14 record. Unfortunately came up just short in a lot of very close matches.

**Baseball:** Finished strong with a 9-11 record that qualified them for the state tournament. Upset Plainville in the first round before falling to Woodland yesterday.

**Softball:** A great 17-3 record and the #5 seed in the Class M Tournament. Won their first round game against Stonington before losing a close one against Berlin yesterday.

**Crew:** A huge finish to the season with a State Championship for our Crew Team!!! Here is a summary of the final races of the season:

“The LSM Crew team competed in their state championship at Lake Waramaug. Both the 2<sup>nd</sup> varsity and varsity girls fours placed 3<sup>rd</sup>, the 3<sup>rd</sup> varsity girls and 3<sup>rd</sup> varsity boys placed second. To finish off the day, both the novice boys and girls 4’s placed first in their events, the 2<sup>nd</sup> varsity boys and varsity boys 4’s took home the gold and varsity 4 trophy. As a whole, the LSM Crew team took home the impressive CPSRA overall high points trophy and won the competition in four boats. Congratulations to all of the boats who medaled this weekend and worked hard to earn the first points trophy in LSM history!”

**Unified Volleyball:** They just finished up a great volleyball season. Had a great end of the year bowling trip and banquet!

**Girls Lacrosse:** Finished with a 12-4 record. Won their first game of the Class S State Tournament against Montville before falling to Canton in the quarterfinals.

**Boys Lacrosse:** A very good 10-6 record on the year. Beat Immaculate in the opening round of the Class S Tournament before falling to Tolland.

**Boys and Girls Outdoor Track:** Some great performances in the Class M State Meets. Aidan O’Connor won the Class M State Title in the Pole

Vault with a jump of 14'3. Sydney Mello finished second in the shot put with a school record throw of 39'9 and also placed fourth in the discus. Both will move onto the State Open next week along with the Girls 4 x 100 relay team of Hope Maher, Lauren Searle, Jaime Jackson, and Madeline Croiger.

**Golf:** Finished the season an undefeated 16-0 in the BL. Went on to win the BL Tournament Title this week by a wide margin. Colby Norton was the top golfer in the BL with a 71 at Fairview. Good luck to the team as they move onto the State Tournament this coming Tuesday!
