Dear Students, Parents, and Guardians,

It is hard to believe that the end of the 2018-2019 school year is almost here. Final exams for all students begin next Monday, June 10th. Here is all of the information you will need:

### Exam Schedule

High school students will begin exams at 7:25 a.m. and exam testing will end at 11:45 a.m. each day. The school buses will pick up students on a regular day schedule. Dismissal from exams will be at 11:45 a.m. (The only exception will be Thursday, June 13th when we will dismiss at 11:35 in order to get the buses back in time for middle school dismissal). Please remember that juniors may not drive to school during exams. Parking spaces are still reserved only for those seniors who have privileges and have registered their vehicles with the school.

Students are not required to be in school for exam periods during which they have no exams. However, those students who choose to come to school when they do not have a scheduled exam must remain in the cafeteria for the entire period. Students who are scheduled to take two exams on the same day may not leave the building during the break between test periods. Students who miss an exam due to a verified absence by their parents are eligible to make-up the missed exam. They should arrange a time with their teacher for a make-up session no later than Friday, June 14th.

The cafeteria will be serving breakfast food and snacks during exam week.

The final exam schedule is as follows:

First Exam 7:25 a.m. – 9:25 a.m.

Break 9:25 a.m. – 9:45 a.m. (break will be only 10 minutes on Thursday, June 13th)

Second Exam 9:45 a.m. – 11:45 a.m. (second exam will run from 9:35 – 11:35 on Thursday, June 13th)
