Hello LSM Community,

From noon to 1:00 students have time for a break and to eat lunch.

From 1:00 – 2:30 a number of clubs and activities will be meeting virtually. That schedule has been sent to students.

As of now we are scheduled to use this special distance learning schedule on September 14<sup>th</sup> and September 21<sup>st</sup>.
